UKRAINIAN PRESIDENT ZELENSKY DESIRES A NEW NORMANDY-FORMAT SUMMIT WITH THE 4 LEADERS

In recent days, Russia has had tens of thousands of soldiers placed (between 80,000 and 100,000 according to various sources) at the border with Ukraine, where the region is already very flammable. Ukraine, which dates back to 2014, has caused nearly 14,000 deaths and 1.5 million displaced people in eastern Ukraine. President Zelensky said he was worried about the Russian "" violent aggression "against his country. He added that" The time has come to step up a gear, to invite us to join the EU and NATO "

This is how the Ukrainian President Zeleensly, expresses his wish stronger than ever, to join NATO, judging that "cannot remain indefinitely in the waiting room of the EU and NATO". The Kremlin spokesman accuses Ukraine of having made "provocations" and explains these positions of soldiers as "military exercises". It would be very important for us that Mr. Macron and Mrs. Merkel use their influence during this videoconference with Mr. Zelensky so that they explain to him the possibility of a definitive cessation of all provocations "[2] on the front, affirmed the spokesperson of the Russian Presidency, Dmitry Peskov, before a scheduled meeting between the three leaders. The spokesman added that there were "less and less" [2] reports of ceasefire violations on the Ukrainian front, but that this was not "a reason to be completely reassured" [2]. During his visit to Paris on April 16, 2021, President Zelensky said he wanted a new Normandy Format summit: "I want all four of us to participate" to discuss "the security situation in the east of Ukraine and the de-occupation (sic) of our territories, "he declared in Paris after a meeting with his French counterpart, in which Angela Merkel

participated by videoconference, himself and President Macron host, at the Elysee Palace.
